On February 14, 2018, Hank Hultquist and Michael Goggin of AT&T met with Joel Taubenblatt, Matthew Pearl, Blaise Scinto, John Schauble and Tim Hilfiger (via teleconference) of the Federal Communications Commission's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau.

During the meeting, AT&T discussed alternative methods for repacking the 37.6-40 GHz band in advance of an auction of millimeter wave spectrum. AT&T also discussed the auction proposal it submitted previously in this proceeding: a clock auction, with generic, fungible spectrum blocks to be followed by an assignment phase. AT&T also urged that an auction of millimeter wave spectrum be held as early as possible.
