Pursuant to the requirements in the Protective Orders (DA 18-624, DA 18-777) issued in this docket, Free Press hereby notifies the Commission of the receipt of a subpoena from the California State Attorney General's Office ("CA AGO"), the scope of which encompasses Free Press filings that contain information designated as Confidential Information or Highly Confidential Information, and Numbering Resource Utilization and Forecast reports or carrier-specific Local Number Portability data made available to Free Press under the respective Protective Orders. The subpoena requires Free Press to produce "unredacted copies of all documents that [Free Press] submitted . . . to the [FCC], United States Department of Justice[], any state Attorney General, and any state public utilities commission, or any other federal, state or local government agency or entity, relating to the Proposed Transaction."

Free Press understands that the CA AGO may share Free Press' Highly Confidential filings in this proceeding produced to the CA AGO with other state attorneys general that are investigating the transaction and that have signed confidentiality agreements with T-Mobile and Sprint and requested access to NRUF/LNP information.<sup>2</sup>
