**REQUEST TO WITHDRAW PETITION
FOR DECLARATORY RULING, ENFORCEMENT ORDER, AND
FURTHER RELIEF AND EMERGENCY PETITION FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF**

Starz Entertainment, LLC ("Starz") filed a Petition for Declaratory Ruling, Enforcement Order, and Further Relief ("Declaratory Ruling Petition"), and an Emergency Petition for Injunctive Relief ("Injunctive Relief Petition"), on January 8 and January 17, 2018, respectively, regarding the deletion of certain Starz programming services from certain cable television systems owned by Altice USA, Inc. ("Altice"). Altice filed Oppositions to the Injunctive Relief Petition and Declaratory Ruling Petition on January 23 and February 5, 2018, respectively.

Starz and Altice have entered into an agreement regarding the carriage of Starz programming services by cable systems owned by Altice. Starz respectfully requests that the
