After thorough review and investigation of all relevant facts, the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) has made its decision regarding your appeal for the Application Number indicated above. Explanation:

- The record shows that your appeal is being made on a FCC Form 471 for which a Notification of Improperly Disbursed Funds Recovery Letter (RIDF) was issued on March 7, 2017. Procedures for filing an appeal are explained in your RIDF. Further information and options for filing an appeal with USAC can be found under the Reference Area/"Appeals" of the SLD section of the USAC website or by contacting the Client Service Bureau. You had sixty (60) days to appeal USAC's decision, which was identified in the RIDF. After the sixty days, the first Demand Payment Letter was issued on August 9, 2017. This Demand Payment Letter (which you are appealing) is a request for payment and is not the USAC decision on the Commitment. Consequently, your appeal is being dismissed.

Since your appeal was denied in full, dismissed or cancelled, you may file an appeal with the FCC. Your appeal must be postmarked within 60 days of the date on this letter.
