On February 14, 2018, I met with Erin McGrath, Wireless, Public Safety and International Legal Advisor to Commissioner Michael O'Rielly. During the meeting, we discussed the 3.5 GHz proceeding, and how the Commission's adoption of targeted enhancements would encourage innovation and robust investment in the band, consistent with Comcast's comments in the record. In addition, we discussed various hybrid licensing proposals raised by parties in the proceeding.

We also discussed the 5.9 GHz band, and I urged the Commission to enable use of the band by unlicensed technologies to support Gigabit Wi-Fi and other applications.
