Under consideration is a Petition for Leave to Amend and Amendment, filed April 21, 1992 by Webb Broadcasting, Inc. The amendment is filed pursuant to §1.65 of the Commission's Rules. It updates the previously reported media interests of certain non-voting shareholders of Webb. More specifically, the amendment shows that certain non-voting shareholders of Webb are also officers, directors and shareholders of Ocean Media, Inc., as follows: 1) Sid Friedman is President, Director and 25% owner of Ocean Media, Inc. He holds the stock as a joint tenant with his wife, Judi Friedman; 2) Frank Field is Vice-President, Director and 12.5% owner of Ocean Media, Inc. Mr. Field holds the stock as a joint tenant with his wife, Joan Field; and 3) Tony Guida is Vice President, Director and 12.5% owner of Ocean Media, Inc. Good cause is shown, and the Petition will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the Petition IS GRANTED and the Amendment IS ACCEPTED.
