CPNI COMPLIANCE ACCOMPANYING STATEMENT

Direct Communications Long Distance, Inc. (Form 499 Filer ID: 817770)

This accompanying statement explains how the operating procedures of Direct Communications Long Distance, Inc. ensure that the Company is in compliance with the rules governing CPNI as found in Subpart U – Customer Proprietary Network Information – Part 64 of Title 47 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

Direct Communications Long Distance, Inc. adheres to all CPNI rules as stated in §64.2001 – 64.2011 concerning the proper use of our customers' CPNI. Specifically, our notice for use of CPNI approval process meets all requirements as listed in §64.2008. To further protect our customers' privacy, we have implemented all safeguards required in §64.2009. This includes:

- The implementation of a system by which the status of a customer's CPNI approval can be clearly established prior to the use of CPNI;
- The training of appropriate personnel as to when they are, and are not, authorized to use CPNI and the documentation of this training;
- The implementation of an express disciplinary process for CPNI violations up to and including termination;
- The maintenance of a record, for at least one year, of our own, and our affiliates' sales and marketing campaigns;
- The establishment of a supervisory review process regarding carrier compliance with the federal CPNI rules for outbound marketing situations; and
- The establishment of annual certification by a corporate officer with personal knowledge of Direct Communications Long Distance, Inc. policies and procedures to ensure compliance with the federal CPNI rules.
- The establishment of procedures for notification of the Commission of any instance where opt-out mechanisms do not work properly to such a degree that customers' inability to opt-out is more than an anomaly.

Direct Communications Long Distance, Inc. filed with the FCC its CPNI Manual, without the sample Forms, as further detailed explanation of how its procedures ensure that it is in compliance with the rules in Subpart U of Part 64 of 47 CFR that was filed with the March 1, 2008 compliance certification so that it is available if needed, and part of your records.
