



ENGINEERING STATEMENT

The following engineering statement has been prepared for Community Family Broadcasting, Inc. and is in response to a request from the Commission concerning an application for construction permit for a new non-commercial FM station to serve Lincoln, Nebraska (File No. BPED-910319MA).

The original application correctly stated that no non-ionizing radiation would exist at any location on the ground which would exceed the applicable standards. However, the Commission requested that the applicant address the issue of steps which will be taken to limit RF exposure to persons authorized to climb the tower. The applicant will simply turn the transmitter off whenever authorized tower personnel climb the tower itself. The tower will be fenced to prevent access by unauthorized personnel. No one will be allowed to work on the tower when the transmitter is supplying energy to the antenna.

The preceding statement has been prepared by me or under my direction and is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
