On February 19, 2019, B. Lynn Follansbee and Mike Saperstein, USTelecom, Mary Henze and Ola Oyefusi, AT&T, Jeff Lanning, CenturyLink, Ian Dillner, Verizon, Jim Stegeman and Luis Rodriguez, CostQuest, Steve Coran, WISPA and Diana Eisner, Frontier (in person) and Robert Tice, Richard Rousellot, Tiffany Smink, CenturyLink, Kathy Franco (AT&T) and Mike Skrivan, Consolidated (via telephone) met with Steve Rosenberg, Roger Woock, Ken Lynch, Suzanne Mendez, Ying Ke and Kirk Burgee of the Wireline Competition Bureau to discuss the FCC Form 477 proceeding and USTelecom's mapping proposal.

During the meeting, the parties discussed USTelecom's FCC Form 477 mapping proposal as described in its previous ex parte in this proceeding,¹ in additional detail. The discussion included additional description of the various data tools that would be used to create what we are calling the Broadband Servicable Location Fabric, which will serve as a map upon which carrier's can report their broadband service areas. The parties also discussed next steps that industry plans to undertake to test out the efficacy of the proposal.

The parties also described USTelecom's conversations with other industry stakeholders about the proposal.
