**WORLDNET TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.
WITHDRAWAL OF OBJECTION**

WorldNet Telecommunications, Inc. (“WorldNet”) hereby withdraws its objection to the copper retirement (“PRTC Proposed Retirement”) that is the subject of the copper retirement network change notification by the Puerto Rico Telephone Company, Inc. (“PRTC”) in the docket referenced above (“PRTC Notice”).

For the reasons set forth in WorldNet’s objection, WorldNet still maintains that the PRTC Notice was insufficient. Moreover, WorldNet submits that the arguments presented by PRTC in response to WorldNet’s objection are evasive and invalid. However, PRTC has since provided WorldNet with supplement information about the PRTC Proposed Retirement. That information has enabled WorldNet, in this particular case, to determine the impact of the PRTC Proposed Retirement on unbundled network elements (“UNEs”) leased by WorldNet from PRTC and that WorldNet, with PRTC’s reasonable cooperation, should be able to accommodate PRTC’s proposed changes by the revised retirement date proposed by PRTC in its response (i.e., March 14, 2019). In light of this, WorldNet has determined to withdraw its objection as to the current PRTC Proposed Retirement, subject to an express reservation of all rights, objections, and claims with regard to this or any other future PRTC notices of copper retirements.
