
This letter is written on behalf of The President and Board of Trustees of The Miami University and with the concurrence of counsel for Southwestern Ohio Seniors Services, Inc., each of which have applied for a new educational FM station at Reading, Ohio, in response to your letter of July 19 granting these parties a sixty (60) day period to remove their mutual exclusivity.

The parties have met on several occasions and are well on their way to working out an agreement that will end the matter. An informal draft of the essence of that agreement is being considered by both parties. If you would further delay any processing for a period of sixty (60) days, it is hoped that the need for a hearing will be eliminated. It is the present plan of the parties to be able to present the agreement to the FCC on or before November 1, 1991.
