Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of the Communications Workers of America (“CWA”), enclosed are executed copies of the Acknowledgments of Confidentiality required by the Supplemental Protective Order (DA 19-80) in the above-referenced docket. The executors of the enclosed Acknowledgments are outside counsel and outside consultants to CWA.

CWA notes in passing that certain provisions of the Supplemental Protective Order appear to be inconsistent with Fed. R. Evid. 502(a). The Judicial Conference Advisory Committee stated in its Explanatory Note to Rule 502(a) that subject matter waiver may be appropriate in situations in which a party “intentionally puts protected information into the litigation in a selective, misleading and unfair manner.” CWA notes that the Commission and other Federal agencies have a similar interest in not permitting parties to make selective or misleading disclosures of allegedly protected information in matters before the agencies.

A copy of these Acknowledgements will be served on counsel of record for the applicants.
