BROADCAST INTERESTS

Central Florida Educational Foundation, Inc. (CFEF) filed an application for a noncommercial FM station on 90.7 MHz (Channel 214C2), Durham, North Carolina on July 17, 1990 (BPED-900717MC). The application was dismissed pursuant to a settlement agreement with a competing applicant on February 14, 1992.

CFEF also filed an application for a new noncommercial FM station on Channel 214A in Salina, Kansas (BPED-901105MK). Subsequently, a new applicant, North Central Kansas Broadcasting, Inc. (NCKB) was substituted for CFEF, and was awarded the construction permit on April 15, 1992, pursuant to a settlement agreement with the competing applicant. Three officers and directors of CFEF are also officers and/or trustees of NCKB, including James S. Hoge, who is the president and a trustee of NCKB; Thomas H. Moffit, Jr., who is a trustee of NCKB; and, Richard Rosenberg, who is the secretary-treasurer and a trustee of NCKB.

CFEF's president, James S. Hoge, was formerly General Manager of WYND-AM, DeLand, Florida, and is now the director of Engineering of WTLN(AM-FM), Apopka, Florida. As noted above, Mr. Hoge is the president and a trustee of NCKB.

A trustee of CFEF, Thomas H. Moffit, Jr., owns 100% of the voting stock of Tennessee Media Association, Inc., licensee of WRJZ, Knoxville, Tennessee. Mr. Moffit is also president and chairman of the board of directors of Foothills Broadcasting, Inc., licensee of noncommercial FM station WYLV, Alcoa, Tennessee. Mr. Moffit is also a member of the board of trustees of noncommercial FM station WEEE, Cherry Hill, New Jersey; and is a member of the board of directors of Alton Rainbow Corporation, the licensee of WTLN(AM), Apopka, Florida. He is also the General Manager of WTLN(AM-FM). As noted above, Mr. Moffit is a trustee of NCKB.

Both Mr. Hoge and Mr. Moffit will sever any connection to WTLN(AM-FM) prior to the initiation of broadcast service on 88.3 MHz in Union Park.
