Attached please find, for filing, the Supplement to Petition of Northern Arapaho Tribal Industries, Inc. d/b/a Wind River Internet (“WRI”) for Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (“ETC”) status in its service area within the federally recognized Wind River Reservation, including the Census Block Groups for which it had winning bids in the Connect America Fund Phase II Auction 903, as announced on August 28, 2018.¹ This Supplement to the pending ETC Petition provides further details regarding WRI’s request to be designated as an ETC to offer Tribal Lands Lifeline services to qualifying Tribal residents throughout its Tribal service area, including Tribal Lands Lifeline-Only services in ETC areas outside of the CAF Phase II census block groups for which it has been awarded high cost support. The Supplement also seeks authority to obtain Link Up support for eligible Tribal customers.

This Petition has been filed via ECFS in Docket 09-197. A Certificate of Service is also included with this filing.
