In compliance with the filing requirements pursuant to the 2016 Alaska Plan Order, Mukluk Telephone Company, Inc. (MTC) submits the attached revised Wireline Performance Commitments. New fiber backhaul has become available in the Mukluk study area, specifically the community of Nome. In cooperation with the middle mile provider, Quintillion, MTC is now able to offer higher broadband speeds. Providing broadband over fiber backhaul also allows MTC to meet the latency requirements for those services in Nome. The other communities in the MTC study area remain satellite fed. MTC continues to offer best effort speeds a 1/256 in these communities as originally filed.
