
On February 26, 2018, Ruckus President Dan Rabinovitsj, Ruckus Chief Technology Officer Steve Martin, and I met with Commissioner O’Rielly and his Wireless Advisor Erin McGrath at our booth at Mobile World Congress, Barcelona.

We demonstrated the Ruckus OpenG CBRS Private LTE solution supporting mobile and fixed services. We then discussed the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking and Notice of Inquiry in the above-captioned proceedings. We made these points during our meeting:

- We were encouraged by the conditional approval of the four Environmental Sensing Capability (ESC) operators on February 22<sup>nd</sup> as well as the FCC Office of Engineering and Technology’s release of the Knowledge Database (KDB) guidance on CBSD certification on January 31<sup>st</sup>.
- We look forward to the Commission’s authorization of GAA operations in the CBRS band so that we can support the commercial deployment goals of our customers.
- ARRIS and Ruckus Networks have customer relationships in the mobile, cable, enterprise, industrial and fixed wireless sectors. It is important that the final rules for the CBRS band support the business needs and deployment plans of each of these constituencies.
- Ruckus continues to support the introduction of unlicensed operations in the 5925-7125 MHz frequency range, on the condition that the existing incumbent operations are appropriately protected. We were encouraged by the publication of the RKF Engineering analysis and look forward to the Commission’s next steps.
