
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 22, 2019, Christopher Guttman-McCabe of CGM Advisors, on behalf of Anterix, Inc., (“Anterix”) spoke by phone with Giulia McHenry, Acting Chief of the Office of Economics and Analytics. Mr. Guttman-McCabe updated Ms. McHenry on the continuously expanding utility and private enterprise interest in the 900 MHz band, including the Commission's grant of a fifth experimental license, this one involving UPS, and the recent Utilities Broadband Alliance event at the Alabama Power facility that was attended by more than 150 industry representatives. Mr. Guttman-McCabe discussed Anterix's commitment to ensure that the railroads are satisfied with the outcome of the 900 MHz proceeding, as they are key to any successful repurposing of the band. The parties also discussed Anterix's support for a “success threshold” as proposed in the Commission's NPRM to address any potential holdouts, as well as the mechanism by which spectrum in the band could be realigned.
