**Notification of Charter Communications, Inc. of Served Census Blocks**

Pursuant to the Commission’s Public Notice<sup>1</sup> and the process set forth in the Commission’s *Order on Reconsideration* in this proceeding,<sup>2</sup> Charter Communications, Inc. (“Charter”) hereby provides the following notification of served census blocks.

The *Public Notice* identifies 3,146 census blocks, not previously identified in Frontier’s initial election, in which Frontier has provided public notice of its intent to serve locations using Phase I incremental support. Charter, having reviewed the census blocks identified in the *Public Notice*, hereby provides notification to Frontier, and to the Commission, that Charter already offers, in 126 of the census blocks newly designated by Frontier, Internet service, and does so at upload and download speeds exceeding 3 Mbps downstream and 768 kbps upstream.

A list of the census blocks already served by Charter are attached to this notice in machine-readable format as Exhibit A. Exhibit A further identifies whether Charter offers Internet access service in the census block under the brand name Charter Communications, Inc.

or whether Charter currently offers such services under the “Time Warner Cable” brand name.

Accordingly, Charter believes that the census blocks in Exhibit A are already served by an unsubsidized competitor, and thus not eligible for Phase I support.<sup>3</sup>
