

PETITION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND

Bible Broadcasting Network, Inc. ("BBN"), applicant for a construction permit for a new noncommercial educational FM station at Fort Smith, Arkansas, by its attorney, hereby respectfully requests the Presiding Officer to grant it leave to amend its above-referenced application (File No. BPED-900816MA) as set forth herein.

This amendment was filed previously with the Commission on May 1, 1992. It was returned to BBN by Commission letter dated May 12, 1992 (copy attached), because the amendment was received so close to the completion of the Hearing Designation Order that the Commission could not consider it therein. The Commission's letter permits the amendment to be refiled at hearing. BBN filed its Notice of Appearance herein on May 22, 1992, and is filing this amendment on the next business day.

This amendment reports that:

(1) On April 29, 1992, BBN consummated the assignment of license of WAVO(AM), Decatur, Alabama, to Curriculum Development Foundation, Inc. This assignment was authorized by the Commission in File No. BAL-920213EC, which was granted March 30, 1992. In April, 1992, while preparing the amendment to report the WAVO consummation, counsel for the first time discovered that prior amendments to BBN's application failed to report the filing and grant of BAL-920213EC. BBN, therefore, updated its application on May 1 as soon as practical after discovery of the error. Counsel apologizes to the Court for the error, and assures the Court that the failure to more promptly update the application was wholly inadvertent;

(2) On April 5, 1992, changes were made to BBN's Board of Directors. Joseph J. Mast was elected Secretary/Treasurer of BBN, replacing H. Ron White, who also resigned as a director; Terry Hylton was elected Assistant Secretary; Joy Davey was married and is now known as Joy Raley; and David Jeremiah was elected to the Board of Directors to replace H. Ron White; and


(3) A previously reported event, the pending Settlement Agreement leading to dismissal of BBN's application for a new FM station at Martinez, Georgia, was consummated on April 23, 1992, and Exhibit 4 was amended to reflect that the application is now dismissed.

Good cause exists for this amendment. It is required by Section 1.65 of the Rules. The amendment also meets the test set forth in Erwin O'Conner Broadcasting Co., 22 FCC 2d 140, 143 (Rev. Bd. 1987). That is: (a) it was presented with due diligence; (b) it is involuntary; (c) no new parties or issues are required; (d) no disruption of the proceeding will occur; (e) no party will be prejudiced; and (f) no comparative advantage will accrue to the amending applicant.

WHEREFORE, good cause having been shown, BBN respectfully requests the Presiding Judge to grant it leave to amend and accept the attached amendment to its pending application.
