
1. Under consideration are a "Petition for Leave to Amend" filed by Orchon Broadcasting Company, Inc. (Orchon) on April 30, 1992; and a letter dated May 6, 1992, from the Assistant Chief, Audio Services Division.

2. Orchon's amendment is filed pursuant to paragraphs 4 and 9 of the Hearing Designation Order, DA 92-359, released April 13, 1992. The amendment clarifies the applicant's previous description of the steps which will be taken by Orchon to limit RF exposure to workers authorized access to its proposed tower site. The Assistant Chief, Audio Services Division determined that the environmental assessment submitted by Orchon satisfies the requirements of 47 C.F.R. Section 1.1311 of the Commission's rules. He requests elimination of the contingent environmental issue specified against Orchon, and the contingent issue will be deleted.

IT IS ORDERED that the "Petition for Leave to Amend" filed by Orchon Broadcasting Company, Inc., on April 30, 1992, IS GRANTED, and the amendment, IS ACCEPTED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contingent environmental issue specified against Orchon IS DELETED.
