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
**LANSLOWNE OF THE POTOMAC HOMEOWNERS
ASSOCIATION, INC. RESPONSE TO OPENBAND OF
VIRGINIA, LLC'S AMENDED SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION**

On August 27, 2018, Lansdowne on the Potomac Homeowners Association, Inc. (“Association”) filed comments opposing OpenBand of Virginia, LLC’s application to discontinue providing telecommunication services to the Association and its residents. OpenBand’s application sought to discontinue service on October 15, 2018. The Association noted that if OpenBand were permitted to discontinue service before the planned transition to a new provider—Comcast—is completed, that would adversely impact the Association and its residents and would not be in the public interest. In response, OpenBand filed an amended application seeking approval to discontinue providing telecommunication services on or about November 15, 2018.

Since the filing of the Association’s original comments, Comcast has been working to complete the transition, and the Association has been advised that the expectation is that the transition will be completed by November 15. There remains, however, a substantial number of customers that still have not been transitioned, and unfortunately, it is not possible for the Association to know at this time whether the transition will in fact be complete by November 15. Accordingly, the Association’s concerns originally expressed in its August 27 comments remain,

and OpenBand's application should only be granted if it ensures that the Association and its residents have had a reasonable opportunity to transition their service to another wireline provider.

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
