Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Federal Communication Commission's ("FCC") rules, the undersigned counsel provides ex parte notice concerning an October 24, 2019 meeting on the Petition for Expedited Declaratory Ruling filed by Yodel Technologies, LLC.¹ During that meeting, Timothy J. 
