**PETITION FOR SPECIAL RELIEF**

La Plata County, Colorado, pursuant to Section 338 of the Communications Act and Sections 76.7, 76.59 and 76.66 of the Commission’s rules, hereby requests (hereinafter, the “Petition”) that the television market of KMGH (Channel 7, ABC, Denver, Colorado) (“KMGH” or “Station”) be modified to include La Plata County (the “County”) in southwest Colorado with respect to satellite TV provider DISH Network (“DISH”) and satellite TV provider DIRECTV (DIRECTV). The County has long been assigned by Nielsen to the Albuquerque, New Mexico designated market area (“DMA”). As such, the County has been “orphaned” by Nielsen due to its assignment to an out-of-state DMA and has been deprived of the ability to receive from a satellite carrier its preferred in-state television broadcast stations. Consumers in the County have up until now have been unable to receive from a satellite carrier important news from their own state capitol, and sports fans in the County have had far fewer opportunities to enjoy televised sporting events such as Denver Broncos football games.

The STELA Reauthorization Act of 2014 (“STELAR”) empowered the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”) to modify a television broadcast

station's local market when it would, among other things, "address satellite subscribers' inability to receive in-state programming in certain areas."<sup>1</sup> This Petition thus falls within Section 338's market modification provision, which allows the Commission to "include additional communities within [a station']...to better effectuate the purposes of this section."<sup>2</sup>

For the reasons explained below, the County respectfully requests that the Commission modify KMGH's local market, as defined in 17 U.S.C. § 122(j), to include the County with respect to carriage by DISH and DIRECTV.

## **I. THIS PETITION SATISIFES THE STATUTORY FACTORS**

As required by STELAR, the Commission determines whether to grant a market modification based on consideration of five statutory factors. These factors reflect the four factors previously applicable to market modifications in the cable context, plus an additional factor to assess "whether modifying the local market of the television station would promote consumers' access to television broadcast station signals that originate in their State of residence." The five factors are:

1. Whether the station or other stations located in the same area have been historically carried on: (a) the cable system or systems within that community; and (b) the satellite carrier or carriers serving that community;
2. Whether the television station provides coverage or other local service to that community;
3. Whether modifying the local market of the television station would promote consumers' access to television broadcast station signals that originate in their state of residence;
4. Whether any other television station that is eligible to be carried by a satellite carrier in the community in fulfillment of the requirements provides news coverage of issues of concern to the community or provides carriage or coverage of sporting and other events of interest to the community; and

5. Evidence of viewing patterns in households that subscribe and do not subscribe to the services offered by multichannel video programming distributors within the areas served by the multichannel video programming distributors in the community.<sup>3</sup>

**A. This Petition Satisfies the Third and Most Important Factor By Bringing an In-State Local Broadcast Station to Consumers Who Historically Have Been Unable to Receive It From a Satellite Carrier**

Where, as here, the purpose of the market modification is to bring a previously unavailable (via satellite carrier) in-state local broadcast station to a community, the third factor should carry significant weight in the Commission’s analysis.<sup>4</sup> Today, because the County is assigned to the Albuquerque, New Mexico DMA, all of its local broadcast content available by satellite is oriented to the interests of a different state. The Station is licensed in the Denver, Colorado DMA, which is in the same state as the County. As the La Plata County Commissioners have previously explained, “La Plata County residents feel disenfranchised and disadvantaged by the lack of access to Denver programming,” and want to receive “news, as well as educational, sports and other programming, from our own state capitol.”<sup>5</sup> It is noteworthy that La Plata County’s plight was a case study in the Commission’s Media Bureau 2011 and 2016 In-State Reports to Congress.

This Petition therefore satisfies the third factor by delivering an in-state ABC-affiliated local broadcast station from Denver, the Colorado state capital, over DISH’s and DIRECTV’s satellite TV service to consumers in the County who have previously been unable to receive it

from DISH and DIRECTV. As the Order explains, this third in-state factor receives enhanced weight when the Commission considers market modification petitions.<sup>6</sup>

This Petition is also timely, given that 2016 is a Presidential election year. In this, and every election year, La Plata County residents do not have access to specific public affairs programming such as televised debates of Congressional candidates or candidates for State office, which compromises their ability to be well informed and well educated as to issues affecting them as citizens of Colorado. Constituents in the County have an interest in seeing their own state officials and news regarding state political campaigns on satellite TV, and this Petition would facilitate such access. As three members of the Colorado congressional delegation remarked in a letter to the FCC during the development of the market modification rules, “[o]ne constituent from La Plata County, Colorado said that in her 15 years as a resident of the county, she had ‘never seen any of the state’s governors or other elected representatives on television.’”<sup>7</sup> Grant of the this Petition would enable DISH and DIRECTV subscribers in the County to receive the Station, which offers Colorado-oriented weather, news, sports, and political coverage, among other things, through their satellite TV package.

#### **B. The Remaining Factors Support This Petition**

The first, second, and fifth factors all relate to historical or current opportunity to view the Station in the County (the first and second factors), and whether the residents of the County

have availed themselves of such opportunities (the fifth factor). Since the purpose of STELAR was to facilitate access to in-state broadcast programming, neither a lack of historical carriage or coverage, nor a commensurate lack of historical viewing patterns for the Station, should weigh against the requested market modification. Because the County has long been assigned by Nielsen to an out-of-state DMA, STELAR's market modification provision marks the first opportunity for the County to receive the Station's signal over satellite. Given this lack of carriage, residents of the County have had scant opportunity to develop any viewing patterns for the Station. It is precisely this lack of opportunity to view, via satellite TV, an in-state network-affiliated station that this Petition intends to remedy.

Regarding the fourth factor, the County is unaware of another in-state local broadcast station carried by a satellite or cable provider in the County that offers Denver- and Colorado-oriented news coverage of issues of concern to residents of the County. In fact, the Commission's Media Bureau 2016 In-State Report notes that neither DIRECTV nor Dish Network offers such carriage.

## II. EVIDENTIARY SHOWING

The County submits evidence as explained below responsive to the evidentiary requirements in the Commission's rules.<sup>8</sup>

- With respect to Factor 2, attached as Exhibit A is a map indicating the approximate highway distance between the County and KMGH's main transmitter site near Lookout Mountain in Golden, Colorado. As the map shows, the County is roughly 330 miles away by car from KMGH's main transmitter site in the Denver DMA.

- With respect to Factor 2, attached as Exhibit B is a map illustrating the location of the County and indicating KMGH’s coverage area based on over-the-air signal strength.
- Although market modifications generally require information on “shopping and labor patterns in the local market,” such data should not impact any decision about whether or not residents of the County should be able to receive Colorado-based local broadcast stations by satellite. As Exhibit A shows, the County is several hundred miles and approximately 7 hours by car away from KMGH’s main transmitter site, suggesting that residents of the County likely do not regularly commute to the Denver area for work or conduct daily shopping errands in that area. Nonetheless, residents of the County will benefit from being able to receive an in-state local broadcast station from Denver, not because the Station is geographically close to them, but because the station provides news, state political coverage, sports and other information that is important to them as Colorado residents. Therefore, to the extent necessary, we respectfully request a waiver of this item as such information is not available to the County and offers little to no value to the Commission in assessing the merits of this petition.
- With respect to Factor 2, attached as Exhibit C is a recent multi-day programming lineup for KMGH, which shows that the Station broadcasts a local news program with Colorado news, sports and weather several times a day, with “7News” airing at 11:00 am, 5:00 pm, 6:00 pm, and 10:00 pm local time.
- Commission rules require that market modification petitions include “[c]able system or satellite carrier channel line-up cards or other exhibits establishing historic carriage [of a given station], such as television guide listings.”<sup>9</sup> There has not been historic carriage of the Station in the County by satellite carriers, and therefore no evidence is being submitted for this element with respect to satellite.
- With respect to Factor 5, Commission rules require that market modification petitions include “[p]ublished audience data for the relevant station showing its average all day audience . . . for both multichannel video programming distributor (MVPD) and non-MVPD households[.]” As discussed above, given the lack of historical carriage of the Station in the County, Nielsen rating or other audience data would not be helpful in evaluating this Petition. Therefore, to the extent necessary, we respectfully request a waiver of this item.

### III. TECHNICAL AND ECONOMIC FEASIBILITY

On June 14, 2016, the County sent to DISH a pre-filing coordination letter pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 76.59(e) of the Commission’s rules (Exhibit D). DISH responded on July 14, 2016 (“DISH Response”) (Exhibit E) and confirmed that based upon DISH’s current knowledge and

satellite coverage capabilities, DISH was unaware of any factors that render the provision of the Station in the County to be “technically infeasible” pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 76.59(e).<sup>10</sup> DISH, however, reserved the right to amend its feasibility certification “at any time due to, among other things, a satellite equipment failure or a different satellite being brought into service for the area that includes the County which has different coverage capabilities than the satellite(s) currently being used.”<sup>11</sup> According to DISH, at this time, any provision of the Station to the County will be in standard definition (SD) format only.<sup>12</sup>

The County also understands from the DISH Response that if a given a Denver, Colorado local broadcast station impacted by a market modification elects retransmission consent with respect to DISH for carriage of its station in the County, “DISH cannot be certain whether it will be able to successfully reach an agreement with the station.”<sup>13</sup> And, if DISH is unable to reach a retransmission consent agreement with a given station, “it will be impossible for DISH to provide that station’s signal into the County.”<sup>14</sup> DISH also clarified that if only some, but not all, of the Denver Big-4 stations and/or PBS “were to deny DISH the right to retransmit its signal into the County, it may be either technically or economically infeasible, or both, for DISH to launch a customer offering with only the remaining stations that did grant retransmission consent.”<sup>15</sup> The DISH Response also notes that “an FCC grant of a market modification could result in, among other things, two different stations affiliated with the same broadcast network

being authorized for satellite local-into-local carriage in the County,” which could “result in DISH being required to pay retransmission consent fees twice for the same broadcast network.”<sup>16</sup> DISH therefore has stated that it “must reserve the right to charge additional fees to subscribers in La Plata County who elect to receive any Denver local broadcast stations that DISH may be authorized to offer as a result of any market modification.”<sup>17</sup>

On June 14, 2016, the County sent to DIRECTV a pre-filing coordination letter pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 76.59(e) of the Commission’s rules (Exhibit F). DIRECTV responded by letter on July 22, 2016 and by email dated August 8, 2016 (“DIRECTV Response”) (Exhibit G) and confirmed that based upon DIRECTV’s current knowledge and satellite coverage capabilities, DIRECTV can provide service to all the zip codes associated within the County with its SD spot beam but cannot provide HD service to some zip codes associated with the request because reception of the signal does not meet the minimum performance thresholds for DIRECTV’s service.<sup>18</sup> DIRECTV also noted that SD coverage will no longer be available after 2018/2019 when the existing MPEG2 satellite is removed from service.<sup>19</sup> By email dated August 8, 2016, DIRECTV clarified its July 22, 2016 letter and added that “regarding economic feasibility, we did not identify any issues that would make La Plata County’s request economically infeasible.”<sup>20</sup> No factors were identified that rendered the provision of the Station in the County to be “technically infeasible” pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 76.59(e).

Attached as Exhibit H is a letter dated August 29, 2016 to Senator Michael Bennet and Senator Cory Gardner signed by Joan M. Barrett, Vice President/General Manager, KDVR-

TV/KWGN-TV, Denver, CO, Walt DeHaven, Vice President/General Manager, KCNC-TV, Denver, CO, Brad Remington, Vice President/General Manager, KMGH-TV, Denver, CO, Mark Cornetta, Executive Vice President TEGNA Media, KUSA-TV/KTVD-TV, Denver, CO and Doug Price, CEO, Rocky Mountain PBS, Denver, CO, wherein the stations indicate their willingness “to negotiate terms of targeted carriage arrangements to allow delivery of local, in-state, non-duplicative broadcast programming and to increase access to in-state news by Colorado viewers.”

Carriage of Denver television stations in La Plata County is an issue of utmost importance to the citizens of our community. In that regard, attached as Exhibit I are public comments recently submitted (over the past 10 days) to the La Plata County Board of County Commissioners in support of this petition. Finally, attached as Annex J is a letter dated October 26, 2016 signed by Senator Michael F. Bennett, Senator Cory Gardner and Representative Scott R. Tipton indicating strong support of La Plata County’s market modification petition.

**IV. CONCLUSION**

For the foregoing reasons, the County urges the Commission to expeditiously grant its Petition.

**FEASIBILITY CERTIFICATION PURSUANT TO 47 C.F.R § 76.59(e)**

1. This certification is issued by DISH Network L.L.C. (“DISH”) pursuant to the pre-filing coordination procedures contained in the Federal Communications Commission’s (“FCC”) Order<sup>1</sup> governing market modifications for satellite carriers under the STELA Reauthorization Act of 2014 (“STELAR”).<sup>2</sup>
2. This certification responds to the letter (“Letter”) from the La Plata County Board of County Commissioners requesting information regarding carriage of certain Denver, Colorado local broadcast stations (including, but not limited to, KUSA/KTVD, KCNC, KDVR/KWGN, KMGH/KZCO, and KRMA) (the “Stations”) to DISH subscribers in La Plata County, Colorado (the “County”).
3. DISH has evaluated the Letter in light of its current satellites and spot beam configurations, and has determined that, at this time, DISH is unaware of any factors that render such carriage “technically infeasible” pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 76.59(e). DISH, however, reserves the right to amend this Feasibility Certification at any time due to, among other things, a satellite equipment failure or a different satellite being brought into service for the area that includes the County which has different coverage capabilities than the satellite(s) currently being used.
4. Based on DISH’s current technical capabilities, any provision of the Stations to the County will be in **standard definition (SD) format only**.
5. To the extent that a Denver, Colorado local broadcast station impacted by a market modification elects retransmission consent with respect to DISH for carriage of its station in the County, DISH cannot be certain whether it will be able to successfully reach an agreement with the station. If DISH is unable to reach a retransmission consent agreement with a given station, it will be impossible for DISH to provide that station’s signal into the County. If any one of the five Stations referenced in your Letter were to deny DISH the right to retransmit its signal into the County, it may be either technically or economically infeasible,<sup>3</sup> or both, for DISH to launch a customer offering with only the remaining stations that did grant retransmission consent.
6. As DISH noted in its comments during the development of the market modification rules,<sup>4</sup> an FCC grant of a market modification could result in, among other things, two different stations affiliated with the same broadcast network being authorized for satellite



local-into-local carriage in the County. This could result in DISH being required to pay retransmission consent fees twice for the same broadcast network. Therefore, we must reserve the right to charge additional fees to subscribers in La Plata County who elect to receive any Denver local broadcast stations that DISH may be authorized to offer as a result of any market modification.

7. Without the ability to offset the additional costs associated with a market modification, it would be "economically infeasible" pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 76.59(e) for DISH to comply with a market modification ordered by the FCC consistent with the request described in the Letter.

The foregoing has been prepared using facts of which I have personal knowledge or upon information provided to me. I certify under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my current knowledge, information, and belief.

To answer your questions about DIRECTV's response to the La Plata County request for a preliminary market modification evaluation, there were seven (7) HD zip codes in La Plata County that were outside our HD spot beam, but we are able to serve all the La Plata County zip codes with our SD spot beam. On the certificate forms, we have also indicated that the SD satellite that currently covers La Plata County will be removed from service in 2018-19, and at that time, only the HD satellite will remain. This means that our ability to serve the whole of La Plata County cease in 2018-19 when the SD satellite is removed from service.

Regarding economic feasibility, we did not identify any issues that would make La Plata County's request economically infeasible.


Second, DIRECTV's response did not speak to economic feasibility. Can we expect a subsequent letter on that point?

Dear Senators Bennet and Gardner:

As broadcasters in Colorado, we appreciate your continued interest in viewers' access to local broadcast TV programming throughout the state. With this letter, we want to confirm previous efforts by Colorado's broadcasters to deliver local programming to the Four Corners region.

In discussing carriage of television signals, it is important to remember that the designated market area (DMA) system serves as the foundation that allows local stations to support service to their communities. The most recent FCC report on DMAs, released on June 3, 2016, again affirmed the DMA structure, determined that departing from the existing DMA system would create enormous disruptions in the video programming industry, and concluded that changes to it would be unlikely to increase the amount of local programming available to viewers. This report also referred to an option for increasing localism that we have addressed previously – voluntary agreements for pay-TV operators to carry in-state stations' local, non-duplicative programming.


Broadcasters in the past have offered this option to pay-TV providers in several different markets, and Colorado broadcasters made such an offer two years ago for Montezuma and La Plata counties. We do so again as a unique, targeted solution for this particular region. Our goal is to provide those counties with local Colorado programming, while not undermining the framework of our nation's local TV broadcasting system.

The stations represented by this letter remain willing to negotiate terms of targeted carriage arrangements to allow delivery of local, in-state, non-duplicative broadcast programming and to increase access to in-state news by Colorado viewers. In doing so, we also need to respect existing programming contracts and important FCC rules that support locally-oriented TV broadcasting. The specifics of such negotiated carriage arrangements will need to be worked through with individual broadcast stations.

In addition, we understand that Rocky Mountain Public Broadcasting is willing to offer its programming without cost to pay-TV entities in Montezuma and La Plata counties. This programming would not be duplicative of other public television programming in the area; similar to the individual Colorado broadcast stations, public broadcasters would need to be engaged directly by pay-TV providers with respect to specifics.

Again, we thank you for your continued desire to work with us to facilitate a successful outcome.

We write in strong support of La Plata County's market modification petition to allow in-state broadcasts from Denver-based stations into La Plata County. Their submission is the result of years of work by the county and its residents who have demanded access to in-state television programming for local news, weather, and sports.

La Plata County is part of the Albuquerque, New Mexico DMA. As such, television subscribers do not have access to Colorado programming, including critical information, such as developments from the state capital, and local sports and weather.

For the past several years, our offices have worked together with the satellite providers and broadcasters to find a workable solution to the orphan county issue. While we were able to find temporary fixes to provide some viewers with Denver television, it is time for a permanent solution. With the Denver broadcasters indicating their willingness to negotiate carriage of their programming to all Colorado viewers, and the satellite companies indicating that carriage is feasible, we hope this petition will resolve the issue for viewers in La Plata County.

We are pleased the Commission set forth the process that allows local governments to petition for market modification, based on language we secured in the Satellite Television Extension and Localism Act Reauthorization (STELAR) Act of 2014. In fact, in its September 2015 final rulemaking, the Commission specifically cited our April 2015 letter detailing La Plata County's situation as an "orphan county" in adopting new market modification rules.

We urge the Commission to swiftly review this petition and work with all relevant parties to quickly complete consideration of the market modification process.
