Petition for Rule Making Filed

A petition for rule making filed on May 22, 1992, by Alcatel Network Systems, Inc. is being released today for public comment and designated RM-8004. The Petitioner proposes amendments to Parts 2, 21, 25 and 94 of the Commission's Rules to reallocate the 3.6-3.7, 3.7-4.2, 5.925-6.425, 6.525-6.875, 10.55-10.68 and 10.7-11.7 GHz bands to permit sharing by common carriers and private operational fixed microwave systems. The Petitioner also proposes amendments that for these bands would define licensee eligibility; prescribe channelization, minimum path lengths, minimum channel loading, and minimum capacity for bandwidth used; establish frequency coordination criteria; and establish antenna standards. Finally, the Petitioner references the relationship of its petition to proposals made by the Commission in its Notice of Proposed Rule Making in ET Docket No. 92-9, 7 FCC Rcd 1542 (1992), and to proposals made in a petition filed on March 31, 1992, by the Utilities Telecommunications Council, RM-7981.

Interested parties may file a statement in support of or in opposition to this petition, and reply to statements filed. RM-8004 must be referenced on the cover page of each statement or reply. Statements must be submitted by July 2, 1992, and replies to statements must be submitted by July 17, 1992.
