

On October 25, 2018, Maria Virella, President of WorldNet Telecommunications, Inc. (“WorldNet”), Lawrence Freedman, Senior Vice President of WorldNet, Kevin Joseph, special adviser to WorldNet, and Christopher Cook of Davis Wright Tremaine LLP, representing Liberty Cablevision of Puerto Rico LLC (“Liberty”), met in separate meetings with Arielle Roth, Wireline Legal Advisor for Commissioner O’Rielly, Travis Litman, Chief of Staff and Senior Legal Advisor for Commissioner Rosenworcel, Nirali Patel, Wireline Legal Advisor for Chairman Pai, Michael Carowitz, Commission Special Counsel, and Jamie Susskind, Chief of Staff for Commissioner Carr. On the same date, the same representatives for WorldNet and Liberty also met in a separate meeting with Sue McNeil, Terri Natoli, Michele Berlove, Claudia Pabo, Ben Childers, Megan Capasso, Pam Megna, Ramesh Nagarajan, Kimberly Jackson, and Daniel Kahn of the Wireline Competition Bureau. In all of the meetings, WorldNet and Liberty discussed their opposition to the US Telecom Petition for Forbearance as applied to Puerto Rico consistent with their previously filed written submissions.
