Dear Ms. Searcy:

In the above-referenced Request for Grant of Pioneer's Preference for its Personal Communication Service, NAC, Inc. ("NAC") requested 250 KHz of unallocated spectrum in the 901-902, 930-931, and 940-941 MHz bands. This request was based upon efficiencies to be gained by utilizing spectrum in these bands.

NAC's preference is to be granted a Pioneer's Preference in the above-mentioned 900 MHz bands. However, NAC respectfully requests that it also be considered for a grant of a Pioneer's Preference in any spectrum band under consideration for Personal Communication Services. This spectrum includes the 1.8-2.2 GHz band proposed in the above-referenced ET Docket No. 92-9.
