On Thursday, February 28, 2019, representatives of the Land Mobile Communications Council (LMCC) (including David Smith of FIT, Mark Crosby, Ila Dudley and Robin Cohen of EWA and Liz Sachs of the law firm of Lukas, LaFuria, Gutierrez & Sachs, LLP), and representatives of The Monitoring Association and the related Alarm Industry Communications Committee ("AICC")(collectively "TMA") (including John Prendergast and Richard Rubino of the law firm of Blooston Mordkofsky Dickens Duffy & Prendergast, LLP), met in person and via teleconference with Charles Mathias, Jonathan Campbell and Scot Stone of the Commission's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. During these meetings, the parties discussed possible coordination protocols, adjacent channel protection measures and related logistical issues associated with the prospective licensing of central station frequencies pursuant to the Commission's October 22, 2018 order in WP Docket No. 16-261. The parties discussed procedures to implement the processing of concurrence requests for central station channels, the status of OMB approval of revised Rule Section 90.175, and the likely timing of the effective date of the new application procedures.
