**REQUEST OF ESPN, INC. FOR FURTHER EXEMPTION FROM LIST OF TOP FIVE
NON-BROADCAST NETWORKS**

The Walt Disney Company and ESPN, Inc. (“ESPN”)¹ hereby submit the instant request (“Request”) to extend ESPN’s existing exclusion from the list of top five national non-broadcast networks subject to the video description rules of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”).² As explained herein, ESPN does not provide at least 50 hours per quarter of prime-time non-exempt programming. Therefore, the Commission should affirm its prior conclusion that the FCC’s video description regulations do not apply to ESPN.

Pursuant to the Twenty-First Century Communications and Video Accessibility Act of 2010 (“CVAA”) and the FCC’s implementing rules, multichannel video programming distributors with 50,000 or more subscribers are required to provide, on a quarterly basis, 50 hours of video-described prime time and/or children’s programming on each of the top five non-

broadcast networks they carry.³ These regulations, however, do not apply to live or near-live programming, *i.e.*, programming that is “performed either simultaneously with, or recorded no more than 24 hours prior to, its first transmission by a video programming distributor.”⁴ Thus, in adopting the video description rules presently in effect, the Commission expressly excluded ESPN from the top five non-broadcast networks because ESPN did not provide at least 50 hours per quarter of primetime programming that is not live or near live.⁵

The Commission further stated that it would update the list of top five non-broadcast networks on a periodic basis to account for changes in ratings of programming networks.⁶ The second update of the list of top five non-broadcast networks is scheduled to occur on July 1, 2018, based upon the 2016-2017 ratings year.⁷ The FCC stated that programming networks that do not air at least 50 hours of non-exempt primetime programming may seek an exemption from the video description requirements.⁸ Accordingly, ESPN is filing the instant Request for further exclusion from the list of top five non-broadcast networks.⁹

As was the case when the FCC adopted the Video Description Order, ESPN does not consistently provide at least 50 hours per quarter of non-exempt (*i.e.*, non-live or non-near live)

prime-time programming. ESPN's programming is well-known to contain a mixture of live sporting events, live studio sports reporting shows, and replays of very-recently taped studio sports programs. This programming includes, among other things the NFL, the NBA, MLB, College Football and College Basketball. ESPN's award-winning studio programming includes SportsCenter, Around the Horn, Outside the Lines, Baseball Tonight, PTI, ESPN Films and SC Featured. Given this mixture of live and studio nearly-live programming (much of which has a significant audio component), ESPN is exactly the type of network that the CVAA intended to exempt.

In preparation for submission of this Request, ESPN reviewed its programming line-up for the past thirteen quarters, from October 1, 2014 through December 31, 2017.¹⁰ As part of this process, ESPN categorized its prime-time content (as defined by the FCC) as to whether it was “live or near-live,” as defined in the FCC’s rules.¹¹ Based on this careful review, and as further detailed in the attached Declaration,¹² ESPN found that for *every one* of the past six quarters, ESPN did *not* air more than 50 hours of non-exempt (*i.e.*, live or near-live) programming during prime-time hours. In addition, attached to this Request are a few illustrative programming schedules from December 2017 that provide additional details with respect to ESPN’s programming schedule.¹³ In short, ESPN continues to “primarily air programming recorded less than 24 hours before it is first aired.”¹⁴ Accordingly, ESPN submits

Declaration of Kenneth Gordon, Jr.

I, Kenneth Gordon, Jr., serve as Assistant Chief Counsel for ESPN. In this capacity, I have recently overseen the review of ESPN's programming schedule for the past thirteen quarters (from October 1, 2014 through December 31, 2017) to confirm that ESPN continues to qualify for a continuing exclusion from the top five non-broadcast networks under the FCC's video description rules.

I asked ESPN employees with access to the schedule for ESPN over the past six quarters to review ESPN's prime-time schedules during that time-frame and to categorize the programming into categories that reflect the FCC's definition of live and near-live programming, as set forth in Section 79.3(a)(7) of the FCC's rules. This review of ESPN's schedule over this time frame indicates that, for every one of the past six quarters, ESPN did not air more than 50 hours of live or near-live programming during prime-time (again, using the definitions of near-live, as set forth in Commission rules). The specific findings for the last six quarters are listed below.

In addition, I asked ESPN employees to review the schedule of each calendar quarter since third quarter of 2014 (i.e., period end date of the last quarter reported to the Commission by ESPN in connection with prior exemption request) and ESPN's analysis found that the average number of hours of non-exempt programming that we aired during prime-time was thirty-four (34) hours per calendar quarter (with all quarters well below the 50 hours per quarter threshold, except for the fourth quarter of 2014 (fifty-two (52) hours) and second quarter of 2016 (fifty-one (51) hours)).
