▼ Narrative

We are appealing the Funding Commitment Decision: \$30,776.16 - MR1: - The FRN was modified from \$7,326.64/month to \$6,411.70/month to agree with the applicant documentation. There are two errors with this decision: 1) the reviewer modified the monthly amount using the amount from the original contract signed for FY2014 that included a chart showing an annual amount of \$76,940.41 (= monthly \$6,411.70) for FISCAL YEAR 2017. Fiscal Year 2017 covers the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 (i.e., E-Rate Funding Year 2016, not 2017), and 2) the applicant's consultant copied the monthly cost in the FY2017 FRN from the FRN on the the 471 application for FY2016 (1699100796) by mistake instead of the Addendum for FY2017, and she also forgot to upload the Addendum for FY2017 as a Submitted Contract for the district. This Addendum lists the monthly cost as \$7,253.82 (= annual \$87,045.84) for FY2017. The original contract for FY2014 with the Addenda for both FY2016 and FY2017 attached has been attached to this Appeal. As a result of these errors, we are requesting that the monthly cost be modified to the correct monthly cost of \$7,253.82 which is supported by the Addendum for the district's FY2017 Internet services.
