**SUPPLEMENT**

Dear Secretary Dortch:

By this letter, Neutral Path Holdings, LLC (Transferee) supplements the above-referenced Application with information requested by the Wireline Competition Bureau Staff. The service areas of Transferee and Infinity Fiber, LLC (Licensee) are adjacent but do not overlap. Cityfront Partners, LLC is a limited liability company formed under Illinois law. None of the entities or persons who will, post-transaction, own ten percent (10%) or greater interest in the Licensee<sup>1</sup> own an interest in any other telecommunications carrier entity, except for their ownership of the two affiliates of Transferee<sup>2</sup> disclosed in the Application (see Application § IV(a)(7)(ii) & Ex. A). Neither of Transferee's two affiliates own an interest in any other telecommunications carrier entity.
