Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am writing in support of including a future agenda item at the World Radio Conference (WRC) to harmonize frequency bands for ENG & PMSE operations, i.e. wireless microphones, as proposed in Document WAC/085 (11.03.19).

We are a small to mid-size church located in central NJ which is not as crowded in the RF spectrum as a large city, however available spectrum is getting tighter as more and more wireless services come on line. With the understanding of the need for RF re-allocation, we also have a need for the use of four to six wireless microphones on a regular basis.

Although this is not a large quantity, having to replace them would place a financial burden on an organization which is already carefully watching where each dollar goes. Having to spend several thousand dollars to replace our wireless microphones means taking money from programs like our food bank and other community services which we provide.

In conclusion we are in agreement that harmonization would provide logistical practicality and economies of scale, especially for covering events in multiple countries. We respectfully ask the FCC to support this topic as a future WRC agenda item.
