Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC" or "Commission") rules, this letter provides notice that on October 30, 2017, Susan H. Crandall, Associate General Counsel of Intelsat License LLC ("Intelsat") and Peter K. Pitsch, Executive Director, Federal Relations and Associate General Counsel of Intel Corporation ("Intel"), met with Louis Peraertz, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Clyburn, concerning the above-listed proceeding.

The parties discussed Intelsat's and Intel's market-based approach to simultaneously enable flexible terrestrial mobile use in the 3.7-4.2 GHz band and protect incumbent satellite operations, as proposed in joint comments by Intelsat and Intel in response to the FCC's Notice of Inquiry on flexible use of mid-band spectrum.¹
