Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am writing in support of including a future agenda item at the World Radio Conference (WRC) to harmonize frequency bands for ENG & PMSE operations, i.e. wireless microphones, as proposed in Document WAC/085 (11.03.19).

As the tour manager and front-of-house engineer for an international recording and performing artist, I am constantly using wireless microphones, instrument systems and in-ear monitor systems. Coordinating wireless frequencies when traveling out of the United States has become increasingly difficult due to the restricted access we have to RF bandwidth. We often must rent or purchase equipment that is different from what we use in the United States when traveling out of the US. This issue is compounded when we tour across multiple countries, as is often the case. Our operations would be greatly simplified with harmonized frequency bands for ENG and PMSE. I therefore urge the FCC to support this topic as a future WRC agenda item.
