CONSENT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

MAW Communications, Inc. (“MAW”) respectfully submits this Consent Motion for Extension of Time (“Motion”) in the above-captioned proceeding against PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL”) pursuant to Subpart J of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”) Rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.1401 et seq. for an ongoing denial of access to PPL’s poles. In support of the foregoing, MAW states as follows:

1. With this Motion, MAW seeks to revise the briefing schedule set forth in the FCC’s February 14, 2019 Notice of Formal Complaint.
2. At and following the time MAW was served with PPL’s 93-page Answer and 231 pages of attachments and exhibits, undersigned counsel to MAW had several firm-wide meetings in Arizona, other work commitments that had been pre-planned for over a year, as well as two personal days planned in conjunction with the work-related travel and thus requires additional time to fully respond to PPL’s allegations in MAW’s Reply.

3. Under MAW's proposed revised schedule, its Reply and Second Set of Interrogatories would now be due March 29, 2019. MAW also proposes to shift each deadline back by four days, as follows:

- a. PPL would object to MAW's Second Set of Interrogatories by April 5, 2019 and PPL would answer them by April 18, 2019.
 - b. The parties' joint statements would be filed by April 8, 2019 (April 6 is a Saturday).
 - c. An initial status conference would be held April 16, 2019 beginning at 11:00am at the Commission.
 - d. Discovery and briefing would be completed by May 28, 2019.
4. PPL has stated it will not oppose MAW's Consent Motion.
