Per FCC Rule 1.1206, this letter provides notice that on March 20, 2019, Michelle Bryan, Executive Vice President, General Counsel and Chief Administrative Officer of Intelsat; John Purvis, Chief Legal Officer, SES; Bill Tolpegin, Chief Executive Officer of the C-Band Alliance (“CBA”); Peter Pitsch, Consultant for Intel Corporation; and Jennifer Hindin and Gregg Elias of Wiley Rein LLP, counsel to the C-Band Alliance (together, the “CBA Parties”), met with Nicholas Degani, senior counsel to Chairman Pai, and Rachael Bender, wireless and international advisor to Chairman Pai.

The Parties reviewed the status and timing of the C-Band proceeding. The CBA Parties emphasized that the market-based approach is the only proposal under consideration by the Commission that can both repurpose C-band spectrum for rapid 5G deployment and protect incumbent operations relied upon as the backbone of content delivery in the U.S. They also explained that the CBA continues to work with industry stakeholders on the technical, operational, and logistical issues related to clearing 200 MHz of C-band spectrum within 18-36 months following a final FCC order.
