Yes, there are a few individuals applying for POTS. Your district no longer qualifies to receive voice services for this coming year and this is the last year for the 90% districts. With Contract 5000 being held up because of an ATT protest, Contract 4000 is still good for another year. The only things that have been approved on Contract 5000 are raw internet (CSpire) and WAN equipment (Venture Technologies). Gary has a list of prices for Contract 4000 if you need them for your application. He placed them on his listserv last week.
