Bandwidth writes to express support for the current Local Number Portability Administration (“LNPA”) transition plan.

Bandwidth is aware of the industry activities which have been undertaken to prepare for a well-tested and smooth transition. Bandwidth has completed a variety of testing to the extent applicable with fully positive results. Moreover, Bandwidth has been advised by its service bureau that it has been certified with the new iconectiv Number Portability Administration Center (“NPAC”).

As is the case with some other service providers, Bandwidth has plans in place to limit customer impact in the unlikely event anything should adversely affect transactions. Bandwidth will be prepared to work closely with our service bureau to resubmit transactions, if necessary, as is the current course of usual and customary practices from time to time.

Simply stated, Bandwidth has confidence in the transition plans which are in place. Bandwidth shares the perspectives expressed by other service providers that the NPAC transition to the new LNPA should proceed as scheduled and without delay.
