On March 21, 2019, Jennifer McCarthy, Vice President, Legal Advocacy of Federated Wireless, Inc. ("Federated Wireless"), together with her counsel, Jennifer Richter and Shea Boyd of Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld LLP, spoke with Michael Wilhelm and Thomas Eng of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau via teleconference.

Federated Wireless provided an update on the significant progress made in the 3.5 GHz Citizen Broadband Radio Service ("CBRS") and the imminent initial commercial deployment and full commercial activities to follow. Federated Wireless also discussed its comments filed in this proceeding and the potential benefits for protection of incumbents, increased spectrum access, and reduced equipment costs that dynamic sharing could bring to the 4.9 GHz band.

Federated Wireless looks forward to further engaging with the Commission and the public safety community on these issues.
