Dear Counsel:

Iowa Network Services, Inc. d/b/a Aureon Network Services ("Aureon") greatly appreciates the significant time and effort that the Commission's staff has devoted to the mediation of this dispute. Unfortunately, the positions of the parties remain very far apart, and Aureon believes that further mediation is futile.

Aureon respectfully requests that the Commission conclude the mediation, and by this letter, withdraws its consent to further mediation of the above-referenced dispute until a reasonable settlement offer is made by AT&T.

Aureon also requests that the Commission proceed with consideration of Aureon's Petition for Reconsideration.¹ The Commission suspended the proceedings associated with the Petition for Reconsideration until the conclusion of the mediation.² Given the end of the mediation, the Commission should immediately end such suspension, and permit Aureon to file its Reply to AT&T's Opposition to Aureon's Petition for Reconsideration by April 2, 2018.
