Sprint Corporation (“Sprint”) hereby submits additional materials with respect to the Federal Communication Commission’s (“Commission’s”) review of the proposed merger between Sprint and T-Mobile US, Inc. In particular, Sprint is submitting two hard drives labeled Hard Drive K and Hard Drive L, respectively, both of which are designated as “HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION – SUBJECT TO PROTECTIVE ORDER IN WT DOCKET NO. 18-197 BEFORE THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION.”

Hard Drive K contains, for the period from August 16, 2018 to March 18, 2019, all: (1) documents presented by Sprint, including by its officers, employees, or agents, to its Board of Directors (“Board”); and (2) resolutions and minutes of Sprint’s Board. These files are contained in “Zip File 1.” In “Zip File 2,” Sprint provides six documents related to Board activity outside of this period that were previously submitted to the Commission. These documents are included for ease of reference because they are relevant to Sprint’s standalone business. Hard Drive K also includes a revised privilege log. Hard Drive L contains the associated load files and images with respect to the documents produced in Hard Drive K.
