

DECLARATION

I, James R. Wilson, III, hereby declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the facts and matters recited below are true and correct:

1. I am the permittee of Class A FM broadcast Station WJUN, which operates on 101.3 MHz at Dothan, Alabama, and the proposed assignee of standard broadcast Station WAGF, licensed to Dothan Broadcasting Co., Inc. (hereafter DBC).

2. I have reviewed the Declaration of B. C. Eddins and hereby affirm that the facts and matters recited in paragraphs 3 and 5 thereof are true and correct. I further affirm that neither I nor any agent of mine has promised or paid any consideration to DBC except for that described in the Asset Sales Agreement.

3. I am a Black American. The proposed assignment is in the public interest because it will advance the Commission's minority ownership policy, conserve Commission resources, and pave the way for the early reactivation of service by WAGF. I represent that if the Commission approves the assignment, I will consummate the assignment within 60 days of grant, resume WAGF's operations within 60 days of consummation and file such proof of performance within such time as the Commission may require to demonstrate WAGF's compliance with Commission Rules and terms of its license.


