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**I. INTRODUCTION AND SUMMARY**

The Lake County Office of Education (“LCOE”) serves seven school districts, special education and pre-school facilities within Lake County, California. Since E-rate’s inception, LCOE has been a very successful participant of the program.

The LCOE submitted and certified their Funding Year 2017 FCC Form 471, #181042111, in the E-rate Productivity Center (EPC) portal of the Schools and Libraries Division (“SLD”) of the Universal Service Administrative Company’s (“USAC”) website, on March 30, 2019. This delay filing was created by many factors that were beyond my control. One of these factors was system issues within EPC that I was unable to resolve right away. The errors related to members of the consortium not appearing to be linked to the consortium, as well as errors within the application’s Recipients of Services section. Although I was prepared to submit the Form 471 on March 22<sup>nd</sup>, the system errors prevented me from doing so.

## **II. Request**

The LCOE respectfully petitions the Commission to request a waiver of the Funding Year 2018 FCC Form 471 filing deadline to allow the Out of Window submission of their E-Rate Funding Year 2018 FCC Form 471 #181042111, due to unintentional lateness of the application.
