Dear Ms. Searcy:

The following representatives of PacTel Paging ("PacTel") met on June 15, 1992^{1/} with Ken Robinson of Chairman Sikes' office, Brian Fontes of Commissioner Quello's office, Byron Marchant of Commissioner Barrett's office, Michele Farquhar of Commissioner Duggan's office, Steve Kaminer of Commissioner Marshall's office, Robert Pepper of the Office of Plans and Policy, Gerald Vaughan of the Common Carrier Bureau and Myron Peck of the Mobile Services Division: Charlie Jackson (President) and Mark Stachiw (Counsel). They were accompanied by Carl W. Northrop (Communications Counsel - Bryan Cave), and Gerald Udwin (Principal -The Udwin Group).

The purpose of the meetings was to discuss the immediate need for the allocation of the 930-931 MHz band for Advanced Messaging Services (AMS) as proposed by Telocator in RM-7617 and other petitioner's for rulemaking, including PacTel, in ET Docket No. 92-100. PacTel Paging advocated that the AMS proceeding should not be rolled into the Personal Communications Services (PCS) proceeding which raises various unique issues relating to the provision of two-way services in the 1.8 to 2.2 GHz band.

^{1/} The meetings on the 15th lasted throughout the day which prevented this notice from being filed on the day of the meetings. 
