IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR SUMMARY DECISION

1. On June 8, 1992, Gadsden State Community College ("Gadsden State") filed a Motion for Summary Decision. The Mass Media Bureau submits the following comments in support.


2. Gadsden State seeks summary decision of Issue 2. See Hearing Designation Order, 7 FCC Rcd 2356 (1992). That issue involves compliance with Section 73.525 of the Commission's Rules. Section 73.525 insures protection from interference of

television stations operating on Channel 6.

3. Based upon an analysis of Gadsden State's showing by the Bureau's engineering staff, we have concluded that Gadsden State's proposal would reduce interference on Channel 6 to an extent sufficient to constitute compliance with Section 73.525. Accordingly, we support the Motion for Summary Decision. Moreover, we note that, upon favorable resolution of Issue 2, Gadsden State will have established that it is qualified to be a Commission licensee. Thus, its application may be granted.¹
