



**REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE OF ALL DATES**


Southwest Allen County Schools and Faith Christian Academy hereby request that all procedural dates in the above-captioned proceeding as delineated in the Judge's Order of May 11, 1992, FCC 92M-550 be continued. In this regard, the parties have reached an agreement in principle to settle the above-captioned proceeding. The settlement would be subject to the grant of the pending application of Southwest Allen County Schools and concurrently the approval of a modification of the application of Faith Christian Academy to specify a new channel and a grant of the Faith Christian Academy application without loss of its current cut-off status. In addition, Southwest Allen County Schools has agreed to reimburse Faith Christian Academy the amount of \$8,500 in partial reimbursement of its legitimate and prudent expenses.

In light of the settlement, the parties urge that all dates be continued.<sup>1</sup>
