Dear Ms. Acosta:

We are in receipt of your letter inquiring about the renewal status of WTRU-FM (formerly WKSJ-FM), Jupiter, Florida. A renewal application (BRH-880926UJ) for that facility was timely filed before its license expired on February 1, 1989. That application is currently pending and will be considered in conjunction with an application for a new station filed by Jupiter Broadcasting Corporation ("JBC") which specifies the same frequency and is thereby considered to be "mutually exclusive" with WTRU-FM's renewal. Since JBC's application is considered to be otherwise acceptable, JBC is entitled by law to a comparative hearing to determine which of the applicants would best serve the public interest. This matter is currently under consideration by the Commission.

Enclosed please find an information packet regarding the processing of radio renewal applications. We trust that this information will be helpful to you in understanding our procedures.
