
This Engineering Statement has been prepared on behalf of Carnegie-Mellon Student Government Corporation, licensee of WRCT(FM), Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, by B. Benjamin Evans of Evans Associates, Consulting Communications Engineers in Thiensville, Wisconsin.

WRCT, a non-commercial educational FM station operating on Channel 202A, has an application pending before the Commission (ARN 891108MA) to increase effective radiated power from 100 watts to 1.5 kilowatts.

Section 73.525 of the FCC Rules requires that all Channel 6 television stations located within 257 kilometers of WRCT be notified of the proposed modification. The only such Channel 6 station is WJAC-TV in Johnstown, Pennsylvania, located 82 kilometers away.
