**WITHDRAWAL OF PLEADINGS**

Bible Broadcasting Network, Inc. ("BBN") by its attorney, hereby withdraws the: (a) "Contingent Notice of Appearance of Bible Broadcasting Network, Inc.," (b) "Contingent Opposition to Motion for Summary Decision," (c) "Petition for Leave to Intervene," and (d) "Emergency Contingent Petition for Reconsideration and Motion for Stay" filed June 24, 1992, in the above-captioned proceeding.

These pleadings were filed because BBN's consulting radio engineer had detected that prohibited contour overlap with BBN's proposed application for modification of the facilities of WYFD(FM), Decatur, Alabama, would result from the grant of the application of Gadsden State Community College ("Gadsden

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
State") (File No. BPED-860307MK) for modification of facilities of WSGN, Gadsden, Alabama.

On June 25, 1992, BBN's counsel was personally assured by the Chief, FM Branch, Mass Media Bureau, that the Bureau had studied the Gadsden State proposal, and that the Presiding Officer's grant of the Gadsden State application would not result in prohibited overlap to WYFD. The Chief, FM Branch, stated that, although other unstudied matters could affect grant of BBN's application, Gadsden State's application would not adversely affect it.

WHEREFORE, in light of this assurance, BBN hereby withdraws the above-listed pleadings.


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
