

Comments on RM-11831

I am commenting on the Kolaik petition FCC ID 10091881205. I ask you to expedite RM-11831, and REJECT RM's 11828, 11708, 11759, and 16-239. RM-11831 ensures that the identity of and monitoring of data signal transmission using existing or non-proprietary interception methods will assure that the transmission does NOT include inappropriate or commercial content being sent over amateur radio bands, and will not include commercial internet or email services as required by Part 97.1, 97.3(4), and 97.113(a)(5). Some of the Automatically Controlled Data Stations (ACDS) have been operating illegally, by using proprietary encryption, which can not be monitored by anyone, including the FCC monitoring station in Guilford, MD. These transmissions are currently interfering with CW operating and HF RTTY/Data sub-bands. I respectfully request the Commission issue a Notice of Proposed Rule Making, and modify Section 97.309(a)(4) of the Commissions rules as described in RM-11831.
