Narrative

The District is located in a rural mountain region of California and has very little internet and phone access. The District is a Necessary Small School and receives a small amount of funding to operate. At the present time the district has 17 students in grades K-8. The District only has two full time staff (one teacher and one aide-secretary-bus driver) and a part time superintendent. The District was awarded a California BiiG2.0 grant that funded transmission towers and equipment to provide a high speed internet to the school. The grant paid for the first year of transmission but that cost transfers the District as of July 1, 2018. The access cost started last year after the deadline to file for e-rate. The District only had one transmission and one access bids as the result of the 471. The District has counted on the e-rate funding to be able to continue the internet. Since we can not afford to hire an outside company to apply for us, we have tried to complete the process our self. As a result, we missed the deadline for filing the 471. We hope to appeal the deadline and have our funding request considered.
